You are being provided this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-01K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Development Services Agency, to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify an adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide an opportunity for the affected public to provide input on the rules.

HWAP Rule Ohio Administrative Code Chapter: 122:12-1

The regulation provides structured, standard guidance on the termination process for providers of the Home Weatherization Assistance Program who fail to meet the obligations of the grant agreement.
